Discussion Questions

1. Hook (Get people talking!)

- Have you ever had a moment (like Evan in the sermon) where a single sentence changed the way you saw yourself? What happened?
- What are some things that can make us feel separated from the love of God?
- If you could overhear God whisper one sentence about you today, what do you wish it would be?

2. Book (Dig into the text)

- How does Romans 8:29 redefine our purpose? What does it mean to be *conformed to Jesus' image*?
- How does verse 32 ("He did not spare His own Son") function as the ultimate proof that your life matters?
- What does "more than conquerors" (v. 37) actually mean in context? What are we conquering?

3. Look (Personal reflection)

- Which of the six whispers (Wanted, Chosen, Matter, Secure, Purpose, Never-Stop-Loving) do you personally find the hardest to believe? And how does that struggle show up in daily life?
- How does knowing your purpose is to be shaped into the image of Jesus change the way you view your story (especially its painful parts)?
- If "nothing can separate you from the love of God" is objectively true, what fear in your life loses its power?

4. Took (Respond in faith)

- What practical step could help you internalize your adoption (i.e. journaling, prayer, memorizing Romans 8, confession, worship, community)?
- In what area (at work, home, church, a friendship, your private life, etc...) do you need to declare, "If God is for me, who can be against me?"
- Whose life might be changed if you whispered a sentence of truth and encouragement to them?
